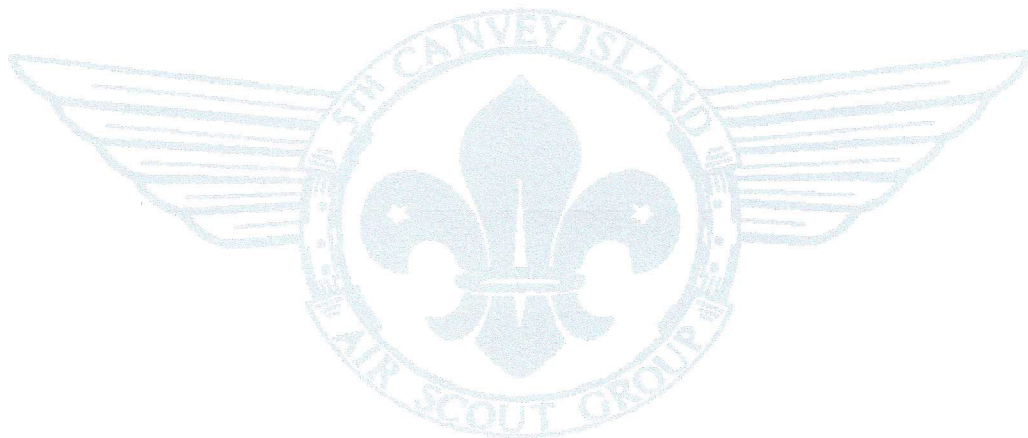




5th Canvey Air Scout Group Constitution
