### **Notes:**

- The items on here are in addition to most of the kit you are wearing on arrival.
- This list is advisory. You are responsible for ensuring you are warm and dry.
- Please ensure your items are named in some way. Lost property will not be left in leaders cars for the next several years!
- Thriftwood in April will be wet and muddy! Strong suggestion is that you do not wear anything you would get upset if it gets wet and muddy.
- Torch; a torch is a torch, not a smart phone flashlight! Please ensure a proper torch is used. A LED head torch is recommended.
- Sleeping bags should be suitable for the time of the year. Thin 1-season bags are not recommended in April.
- Please pack belongings yourself, this way you know where your equipment is when it is dark.
- NO suitcases! A large rucksack or holdall is recommended.
- Do not forget a packed lunch if you want food Friday lunchtime.
- We will be walking at least some of the way to Thriftwood (not with all your equipment thankfully). Hike boots will be needed along with suitable equipment and clothing.
- It is group Policy that mobile phones are not to be taken on camp. Please adhere to this.
